Sign-Up for Winter League

You can't tell from the weather, but winter is here!

With the mild weather so far in November, we can only hope that our "shooting weather" will stay mild for Winter League at SJV.

Winter League this year will consist of trap, skeet, and 5-stand. Trap and Skeet will be 5-person teams and 5-stand will be 3-person teams. If you don't have a full team of five, we can add individuals to your team or add you on another team to make up a team of five people.

Each discipline will consist of 325 targets, over a 12-week period. The last week for signup is January 29th and each shooter must have 4

completed rounds by this date. Shooting ahead is allowed, but shooting behind is not after January 29th.

Club hours for winter league are as follows:

Wednesday 10-5: Trap/Skeet

Saturday 10-4: Trap/Skeet

Sunday 11-4: Trap, Skeet, and 5-Stand.
